

## Important information for Renewing your Real Estate Licenses in NC and/or SC

<p><b><u>NC Licensee (only)</u></b> – Renew license every year before June 30<sup>th</sup></p> <p>MUST complete 8 hrs CE <b>before June 10<sup>th</sup></b> (no CE available during black out period from 6/10 - 6/30)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 4 hour mandatory GenUp</li><li>• 4 hour elective (classroom or online)</li><li>• Note: agents with BIC status or BIC-eligible must complete 4-hr mandatory BICUp instead of GenUp</li></ul> <p>One CE <i>exception</i>: agents with NC licenses issued <i>after</i> July 1<sup>st</sup> of the previous year are not required to complete CE prior to their <i>first</i> renewal. <b><u>MUST</u></b> renew license <b>before June 30<sup>th</sup></b></p> <p><b>ALL NC licensees must renew and pay \$45</b> renewal fee online at <a href="http://www.ncrec.gov">www.ncrec.gov</a> beginning May 15<sup>th</sup>.</p> <p>Only digital licenses are available. No pocket cards provided.</p>	<p><b><u>SC Licensee (only)</u></b> – Renew license every <i>two</i> years before June 30<sup>th</sup> (check <u>expiration</u> date on your <b>SC</b> pocket card)</p> <p>SC Licensees who have an expiration date of June 30, 2023 will need to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• complete six (6) hours of elective and</li><li>• four (4) hours of core real estate continuing education to enable you to renew your real estate license prior to June 30, 2023.</li></ul> <p>All ten (10) hours can be taken online or in the classroom.</p> <p>CE Courses are available in a package at <a href="http://www.mckissock.com">www.mckissock.com</a> and/or <a href="http://www.ceshop.com">www.ceshop.com</a>. Courses are available at York Tech.</p> <p>CE hours* must be in CEBroker &amp; approved prior to your going online to renew your license at <a href="http://www.llronline.com">www.llronline.com</a></p> <p>Note: to renew online <u>you must have your current email address on file</u>. You will receive updated pocket cards which will be mailed to the office.</p> <p>Good news: <b>No required fingerprinting</b> for SC license renewal this year.</p>
<p><b><u>Licensed in NC and SC - and live in NC</u></b></p> <p>No <i>additional</i> CE required. Credit is given for NC course completion. <b>You must self-report</b> the CE completion at <a href="http://www.CEbroker.com">www.CEbroker.com</a> (instructions below)</p> <p>NC/SC licensees who <b>live in NC</b>, go to <a href="http://www.CEBroker.com">www.CEBroker.com</a> to self-report your NC CE hours in order to renew your SC license.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Create login and password.</li><li>• Click on the “Report hours/Exemptions” tab and choose the “Report Exemptions” tab. Note: you are <i>exempt</i> from taking SC CE because you are licensed in <i>another jurisdiction</i> (state of NC).</li><li>• Select license period: 2023-2025.</li><li>• Upload .pdf copies of your completion certificates.</li><li>• Or, upload a .pdf copy of CE record from your NC license profile on <a href="http://www.ncrec.gov">www.ncrec.gov</a>, reflecting 8 hrs CE completed.</li><li>• <b>NO fingerprinting</b> is required for this renewal.</li></ul> <p><b>Call Toll Free: 1-877-434-6323 for CE Broker customer support.</b></p>	<p><b><u>Licensed in NC and SC - and live in SC*</u></b> <i>even if your business address is NC</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must complete NC’s annual 8-hr CE requirement</li><li>• <b>PLUS.</b> Must complete SC’s bi-annual 10-hr CE requirement</li></ul> <p><b>Where you live determines your CE requirement to renew in SC. If you have lived in SC longer than 6 months, SC and NC CE is required.</b></p> <p>*Course providers in SC must now report your SC course completions to SC RE Commission. You must self-report your NC CE hours.</p> <p>It is suggested that you renew your SC license <u>the first week of May</u> when online renewals (at <a href="http://www.llronline.com">www.llronline.com</a>) are opened so that you have time to correct any discrepancies in your course completions.</p> <p>SC’s new updated database will not allow you to renew if 10 hrs of CE course completions are not on record, if you are a SC licensee and live in SC.</p> <p>When you take a course, make sure to keep any completion records you are provided.</p>
